In Nov 2022, Peedus People did another spiked bit drive along with PETA, India. We

*Identified 100 Horse-carts with owners contact info using spiked bits

*Made a spreadsheet and provided it to PETA

*Got permission from SSP Mohali & Panchkula to take a constable along

*Created awareness to Chandigarh Police against Spike-Bit use

*Along with PETA we gave away 100 Free spiked bits to cart owners

*Press conference was done to spread awareness to citizens

In Nov the same drive is planned to be run in Zirakpur, Amritsar and DeraBassi.

PETA has done this in several cities in India but they have never identified and replaced so many spiked bits. This is solely because of Equine Cruelty Prevention Managers efforts

Since Jan 23, Peedus People and PETA are aiming to team up to do a survey of horse-cart owners interested in replacing horse-carts with E-rickshaws.

This effort is ongoing (Feb 2023)

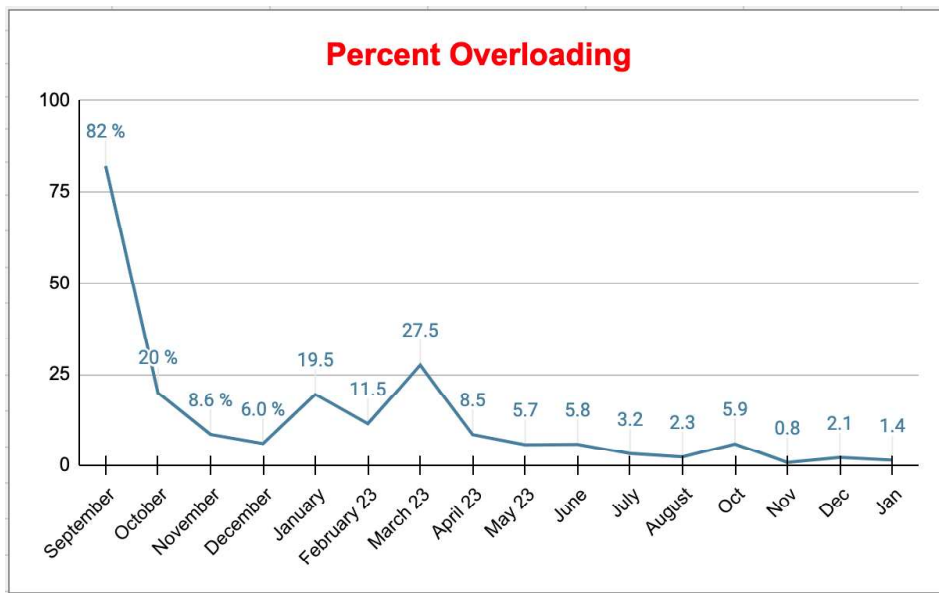
